„Experimental Team“ in the Banner of the „Experimental Reports“

All HZB staff members who contributed to the performance of the experiment must be included in the "Experimental Team" of the report.

Format of text

For sake of legibility **do not use a font size not smaller than 11 points** for the text of your experimental report.

Format of figures

Ensure that **symbols** and **lines in figures** and **figure captions** are distinguishable and legible in the final form of the report.

Note for postscript files

Practice has shown that postscript-files often cause problems when converted into pdf-format for publishing. Therefore we would appreciate very much to receive your report as a word-file or alternatively as an already converted pdf-file, which you could check for correctness directly.

However, if you intend to hand in your report in postscript format, please ensure in any case that all used fonts are embedded while creating the postscript file. Without the original fonts the conversion of your report into pdf-format will probably give poor results.
