Keywords: Biomolecule, neutron, X-ray, structure, hydration

Layout: Abstract should be written within 1 page of A4 (210 mm width and 285.5 mm height). Margins are 20 mm on all sides. Title, authors' names, affiliation list of all authors, representative person's e-mail address, and keywords of the presentation should be listed on at the top of the paper with centering

Format details: The title is written in 14pt Times font with bold style and the first letters of each word is capitalized except for prepositions. Authors are recommended to use 11pt Times font with 16pt line spacing for the remaining header script, as well as text body. The authors' names should be numbered by the affiliation, and the presenter's name underlined. Keywords (up to five words) are listed after notation 'Keywords:'.

The body text starts after a blank line under the header script. Figures, tables, and references can be inserted. The reference number should be specified by a superscripted number, like this¹. Make sure that the character size of the captions is not too small.

Submission: Authors are requested to upload their abstract as a PDF formatted file on the Workshop website² before 31st December 2008. After the deadline, the abstract submission site will automatically close. The abstract file to upload should be named by the authors' name and preferred session (SES).

Sessions are: SES = LSS (Large scale structures of biomolecular assemblies), CSB (Crystallographic structure of biomolecules), DYB (Dynamics of biomolecules), ECB (Extreme conditions), MOD (Modelling of biomolecular systems), MTB (Microscopy & tomography on bio-matter)

For example: John-Smith_SES.pdf. The maximum size of uploaded file is 5MByte.
