

(1) Range of available accommodation to meet various budgets of delegates:

Accommodations: 70-400 U\$/night (maximum 2 persons/room in general); normally, 150-250 U\$ is good.

* If someone need cheaper ones, they can find them easily (50-70 U\$).

(2) What is the estimated registration fee, based perhaps both on a conference of 500-600, and one of 1000 delegates:

750 U\$ (for a conference of 500-600)

650 U\$ (for a conference of 1000)

(3) Evidence of support from national societies:

2021 is too far from now; so, no one can give any quarantees for financial supports. In Korea, such financial supports for 2021 can be realized in 2020. So, we should do lots of hard works in 2020 to get financial supports for 2021; these are the duty and responsibility of ours (Organizing Co-Chairs and Program Co-Chairs). At this moment, I can say that please do not worry about any additional financial supports for SAS2021.

In an oral base, we have some commitments from Pohang Accelerator Laboratory and HANARO (Neutron Facility); they are two big supporters. In addition, we have a plan to submit a grant proposal to the National Research Foundation of Korea in 2020. Also, we will make some funds from some comapnies which are working with Pohang Accelerator Laboratory and HANARO Facility.

In conclusion, there is no concern or worry on the finance for SAS2021.
