



Anders Hagfeldt

Anders Hagfeldt is Professor in Physical Chemistry at Uppsala University, Sweden. He is a project leader of Center for Molecular Devices (CMD) and co-founder of the company Dyenamo AB. He obtained his Ph.D. at Uppsala University in 1993 and was a post-doc with Prof. Michael Grätzel at EPFL, Switzerland (1993-1994). He has published more than 280 scientific papers that have received over 22,000 citations (with an h-index of 72), and has 8 patent applications. He was ranked number 46 of the top-100 material scientists of the past decade by Times Higher Education in 2011, and in 2012 he was awarded the Nature Award for Mentoring in Science. He is a member of the Royal Society of Sciences in Uppsala and the Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences in Stockholm. He is a Visiting Professor at Nanyang Technological University, Singapore, and a Distinguished Adjunct Professor at King Abdulaziz University, Saudi Arabia.
