



## Wonyong Choi

Wonyong Choi received B.S. from Seoul National University (Korea) in 1988, M.S. from POSTECH (Korea), and Ph.D. from CALTECH (USA) in 1996. He then worked at NASA Jet Propulsion Laboratory from 1996 to 1998 as a postdoctoral scholar. He joined POSTECH in 1998 as an assistant professor and became a full professor in 2008. His main research interests are mainly focused on semiconductor photocatalysis and photochemistry for solar energy conversion and environmental applications and advanced oxidation processes. Dr. Choi has published more than 200 articles which have been cited more than 17,500 times in scientific journals (H-index 53). He was granted Young Scientist Award (*KAST*) in 2005, Lectureship Award for Asian and Oceanian Photochemist (*Japanese Photochemistry Association*) in 2008, Namgo Chair professorship (POSTECH) in 2012, and elected as Fellow of Korean Academy of Science and Technology (*KAST*) in 2014. He serves as an editor of *Journal of Hazardous Materials* (*Elsevier: 2008-present*) and has been in the advisory board of *Journal of Physical Chemistry* (*ACS: 2009-2011*) and *Energy and Environmental Science* (*RSC: 2008-present*).
